### **Biographical Notes:**

Don Ferguson's collection consists of 358 individual pieces of piano sheet music spanning the first seven decades of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

There are also two string quartette scores named *Quartette* by Mozart and Beethoven for two violins, viola, and cello. They were published in Leipzig, Germany in the 1940s and were given to Mr. Ferguson by a member of the Bern, Switzerland Symphony Orchestra.
