To approve the following COURSE ADDITIONS:

A. College of Liberal Arts, Department of Communication Studies

- 1.) CMM 574 Health Communication 3 hours

Rationale: This is an appropriate addition to the curriculum of the Communication Studies Department.

- 1.) HST 511 American Social and Cultural History 3 hours

- 3.) PSY 617 Applied Developmental Psychology 3 hours


Rationale: All are appropriate additions to the Department of Psychology curriculum.
