Recommends approval of the following **COURSE CHANGE**:

Change in title for CI 479:

From: Secondary Education: Teaching Mathematics

To: Middle/Secondary Education: Teaching Mathematics

RATIONALE: According to NCATE, we need a methods course for students with a specialization in 5-8 mathematics. At the present, CI 479 is taught once a year with an enrollment of 6-10 students with a 5-12 specialization in mathematics. We expect to have 6-10 students each year with a specialization in 5-8 mathematics. Rather than justify two small classes each year, we prefer to offer one larger combined class. We do not believe that combining middle and senior high students will weaken preparation to teach mathematics.
