To approve the following COURSE CHANGE:

BMS 630 Neuroscience From 5 hours credit to 6 hours credit

(A change in course credit hours only)


RATIONALE: This change will increase the Neuroscience course credit hours from 5 to 6. This will match the sum of the two components of this course (ACB 628) Neuroanatomy at 4 credit hours and (PHS 628) Neurophysiology at 2 credit hours. Graduate students in the biomedical sciences can register either for the entire course: Neuroscience 6 credits or for one or more parts of the course: Neuroanatomy (4 credits) and/or Neurophysiology (2 credits).
