**RATIONALE:** Intellectual history is now taught as a separate subfield; the changes in HST 310 and HST 402 reflect developments in the fields of social, cultural, and intellectual history. HST 400, formerly the undergraduate research course, will now serve as a capstone course. HST 378 meets the department's need for a survey course focusing on the region and on American interaction with Asian nations.
