Smoking Policy for Marshall University

Whereas there is a large and growing body of evidence that smoking and passive smoking is inextricably linked to a variety of cancer and other potentially fatal diseases, but recognizing that smokers have rights as long as their smoking does not impinge on the rights of nonsmokers, smoking policy for Marshall University effective 07/01/93 is:

There shall be no smoking anywhere in any Marshall University vehicle or building, including the football stadium, with the following exceptions:

1. Smoking is allowed in university residence halls in individual student rooms that are designated as smoking rooms.
2. Smoking is allowed in properties leased by the University to others.

RATIONALE: To revise the existing smoking policy of Marshall University in order to expand smoke-free areas on University property in view of complaints raised by non-smokers and smoking policies adopted by other institutions of higher education.
