Recommendation

SR-90-91-(68)220 (AHC)

That, if a class has two possible final examination periods, the time and day of the final examination be determined by the time and day of the first meeting of the class during a regular week of classes. e.g., for classes meeting at 8:00 a.m. M -- F, the time of the final will be determined by the 8:00 a.m. Monday class.

RATIONALE: This policy will eliminate ambiguities in the finals' schedule and confusion for students and instructors alike. Furthermore, it will be useful for students who take the finals' schedule into consideration when they register for classes.
