Recommendation

SR-89-90-109 (ASCR)

That the signature requirement of faculty be eliminated on student drop slips and that new class lists be published more frequently by the Registrar, especially after the W period.

RATIONALE: The present policy requires the student to obtain the signature of the faculty member prior to dropping a class. The proposal is to eliminate the signature requirement and simply allow a student to drop by presenting themselves to the Registration area with their I.D. card and completed drop slip, less faculty signatures. The only signatures that would continue to be required would be those necessary to conform to the undergraduates colleges' various academic probation and mandatory advising policies.
