- **COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT:**

***COURSE TITLE:** Teach Elem School Math CI 301 3 credit hours

***Change Course Title to:** Teach Elem/Mid School Math

***Rationale:** That name of this course is being changed to better reflect the content of teaching mathematics for elementary and middle school students, instead of only elementary students.

- **COLLEGE OF SCIENCE:**

***COURSE TITLE:** Living Systems (and attached) IST 111 (and attached) 4 credit hours

***Change in Alpha Designator to:** NRE

***Rationale:** With the reorganization of the College of Science, the Environmental Science program will be housed in the Department of Natural Resources and the Environment. The alpha designator NRE will designate courses in this department. The alpha designator change is requested for NRE 111 and the 8 additional courses listed below to support the new organization. No other changes to the courses are included in this request.

***Change Course Title to:** Water Policy and Regulations

***Change Alpha Designator to:** NRE


***Change in Catalog Description to:** Examination of how aquatic resources are protected for human and species of concern by current regulatory framework.

***Rationale:** Course originally examined the impacts of disturbance on humans and species of concern within the framework of the National Environmental Policy Act and the Endangered Species Act. This course content is broadened to encompass consideration of the Clean Water Act, the Safe Drinking Water Act and other important regulations and polices.

Additionally, with reorganization of the College of Science, the Environmental Science program will be housed in the Department of Natural Resources and the Environment. The Alpha Designator NRE will designate this department. The Alpha Designator change is requested to support this new organization.


