RATIONALE:

A significant portion of Marshall University's budget comes from legislative appropriations, which have decreased over the past several years.

Legislators cannot fully understand the impact of these cuts without communication from the Marshall community.

Therefore, we recommend inviting members of the Legislature to campus on ~~November 16,~~ 2017, at 5:00pm to have a discussion with the Marshall community.
