Legislative Affairs Committee RESOLUTION

SR-17-18-54 ACF

Whereas, the Advisory Council of Faculty is a legislatively mandated organization whose purpose is to bring issues of faculty concern to the HEPC, CTCC and the WV Legislature;

Whereas, the Advisory Council of Faculty consists of representatives elected by the faculty of each public college and university in West Virginia;

Whereas, the Advisory Council of Faculty will meet in July, 2018 to adopt their issues for the 2017-2018 academic year;

Be it resolved, that the Faculty Senate of Marshall University recommends that the ACF adopt the issues as listed below:

For the WV Legislature:

Create a steady stream of revenue for the higher education of WV students.

Secure the solvency of PEIA with adequate funding.

Preserve academic freedom by protecting the tenure system.

Preserve the autonomy of Boards of Governors of academic institutions to establish policy regulating the safety of their campuses, including what deadly weapons shall or shall not be allowed on campus.
