Recommends approval of the listed **UNDERGRADUATE COURSE CHANGES** in the following college and/or schools/programs:

#### College of Arts and Media

Name of Course: ART499 Senior Capstone Project

**Rationale**: The title change from "Project" to "Exhibition" is reflective of the current course outcomes and assessment. The addition of "BA" is a means to clarify the difference between ART498 and ART499.

Name of Course: ART498 Senior Capstone Project BFA

**Rationale**: The changes in title and course description are in response to the creation of a two semester capstone experience for out BFA students.

### **College of Health Professions**

Name of Course: MI307 Radiation Protection and Radio

**Rationale**: We are splitting the current course into two courses. One will focus on the biological impact of ionizing radiation and the other (a new course) will focus on radiation protection and safety. School of Medical Imaging is preparing to offer an educational track in radiation oncology and two separate classes will be beneficial for that future imaging modality.

### College of Liberal Arts

Name of Course: PSY100 Careers in Psychology

**Rationale**: We believe the new title will better represent the content of the course, and will also better match the current catalog description.
