Recommends approval of the listed **UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM CHANGES** in the following college and/or schools/programs:

College of Health Professions

Name of Program: HA10 BS in Athletic Training

Rationale: The program is currently updating the undergraduate curriculum for the athletic training program to comply with the programs 2020 CAATE accreditation standards. Per accreditation standards 54 and 55, programs are required to add courses in biology, chemistry, physics, psychology, anatomy, and physiology.

1. **Standard 54-The professional program requires prerequisite classes in biology, chemistry, physics, psychology, anatomy, and physiology at the postsecondary level. Annotation The program determines the classes that meets these standards and supports the program's curricular plan. Additional prerequisite coursework may be required as determined by the program.**


2. **Standard 55-Students must gain foundational knowledge in statistics, research design, epidemiology, pathophysiology, biomechanics and pathomechanics, exercise physiology, nutrition, human anatomy, pharmacology, public health, and health care delivery and payor systems. CAATE 2020 Professional Standards 11 Annotation Foundational knowledge areas can be incorporated as prerequisite coursework, as a component of the professional program, or both.**


