- Bachelor of Science in Engineering (BSE)
- Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering (BSME)
- Bachelor of Science in Medical Imaging (BS)
- Bachelor of Science in Medical Laboratory Science (BS)
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)
- Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Care (BS)
- Bachelor of Social Work (BSW)

RATIONALE:

Each of these programs submitted a comprehensive five-year Program Review. Based upon careful evaluation of these reviews, the Academic Planning Committee voted to recommend that each continue at its current level of activity.

** There is one caveat and that is that the BS in Cytotechnology will continue at its current level until all currently enrolled students have graduated. No new students are being admitted at this time due to Cabell Huntington Hospital's impending closure of the program's fourth year of clinical coursework.
