**SR-19-20-30 CC**

Recommends approval of the listed **UNDERGRADUATE MAJOR ADDITION, DELETION, CHANGE** in the following college and/or schools/programs:

**College of Arts and Media**

**Major Addition: Musical Theatre**

**Rationale:** This is not a major in music nor a major in theatre but is, rather, a distinctive major in the musical theatre discipline. This program has the potential to attract a large number of new students to CAM not otherwise be interested in a major in music or theatre. Well over 50% of students who attend college recruiting events in theatre express a strong interest in majoring in musical theatre, and this program will also attract students active in show choir programs, which are popular in area high schools. Further, this program will allow CAM to enrich its public performing arts programs. The School of Music and the School of Theatre and Dance already have most of the courses in place to offer in this new major, and this new major will result in higher subscription rates for these existing courses. Very Few new courses will need to be developed; consequently, no new faculty hires will be required, and faculty teaching rotations can accommodate the new courses. This program will be offered jointly ("co-owned") by the School of Music and the School of Theatre and Dance and jointly administered by the Directors or the two schools.

- Changed STHM 410 Sport Management Professional Core course to STHM restricted elective for all emphasis except general management emphases as required course.
- Delete PLS courses as it is no longer offer

***Changes of the Emphasis Course requirements***


1. Changed restricted electives from 9-12 credits on different emphasis to 6 credits across all emphasis. Updated the list of restricted electives courses.
2. Updated the required courses for emphasis in General Management, Sport Marketing, Sport Agency, and Sports Studies.
