SR 20-21-04 EC

Recommends that the university make public the metrics being used to determine the restrictions for on-campus activity.

RATIONALE:

Cases of COVID-19 among members of our campus community pose an immediate public health threat. Moreover, outbreaks on the Marshall University campuses impact not only Marshall University but also the larger Huntington and South Charleston communities. As such, criteria for the suspension of face-to-face classes, in-person activities, and in-person business conducted in campus offices should be made public.
