Recommends approval of the listed **UNDERGRADUATE AREA OF EMPHASIS CHANGE** in the following college and/or schools/programs:

College of Science

Area of Emphasis Change: SI22 Computer Appl Development

Brief Summary of Changes: Rename the AOE and revise requirements.

Rationale: We are revising the overall SI20 major to replace STA 225 with STA 150/150L. At the same time, we are deleting the SI26 Web Appl. Development AOE to combine it with this one. This AOE will be renamed 'Computer and Web Application Development.' SI 27.
