**BUDGET AND ACADEMIC POLICY COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDATION**

SR 21-22-07 BAPC

The Budget and Academic Policy Committee recommends that all undergraduate students who are enrolled in an online degree program (<https://www.marshall.edu/online-learning/#degrees>) should receive priority registration status and be allowed to register during the priority registration window.

RATIONALE:

Online courses are popular with our on-campus student population because they offer added flexibility. As a result, many online courses fill up before online degree students are allowed to register with their cohort. Frequently, 100-200 level courses are full by the time freshmen and sophomore registration begins, making it extremely difficult for advisors to help them build schedules that fulfill degree requirements and thus satisfy Financial Aid guidelines.
