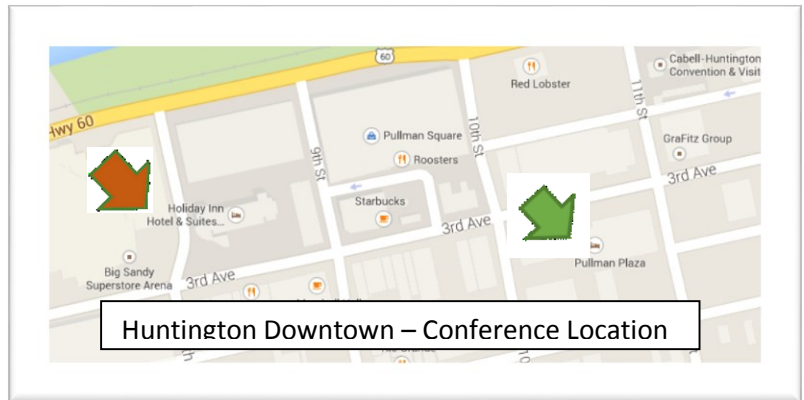

Travel Directions to Downtown Huntington

- **From I-64 Westbound:** Use Exit 11 (Hal Greer Blvd). Turn right at the end of the ramp, which becomes Hal Greer Blvd (also known as 16th Street). Continue along Hal Greer Blvd to the 3rd Ave intersection (at Marshall University). Take a left onto 3rd Ave and continue into downtown (about 1 mile). The Big Sandy Conference Center and Holiday Inn are at the 8th Street intersection.
- **From I-64 Eastbound:** Use Exit 11 (Hal Greer Blvd). Turn left at the end of the ramp, which becomes Hal Greer Blvd (also known as 16th Street). Continue along Hal Greer Blvd to the 3rd Ave intersection (at Marshall University). Take a left onto 3rd Ave and continue into downtown (about 1 mile). The Big Sandy Conference Center and Holiday Inn are at the 8th Street intersection.
- **From US-52 (Ohio) Eastbound:** Follow US-52 eastbound into Chesapeake. Cross the Ohio-West Virginia Bridge. Turn left onto 4th Ave and continue through to the 8th Street intersection (where a left turn will take you to the Big Sandy Conference Center and Holiday Inn at 3rd Avenue).

Conference Parking:

For conference attendees not staying in one of the downtown hotels (which offer free parking), garage parking is conveniently located across from the Big Sandy Conference Center, including two parking garages located at Pullman Square. There are also street meters, though these may have a 2-hour time limit. It is recommended to use Pullman Square garages, which allow for inexpensive 24-hour parking.

Air, Rail & Bus Travel:

The two nearest airports are **Huntington Tri-State** (HTS, www.tristateairport.com) and **Yeager** (CRW, www2.yeagerairport.com/) at 10 and 60 miles distant, respectively. Huntington is served by **Amtrak** (HUN, www.amtrak.com) on the *Cardinal* line and by **Greyhound** (www.greyhound.com).
